- Buoy #7219 and Peat #7204

**Size**

- Small

**Finished Measurements**

- Hat Circumference: 13" unstretched

**Gauge**

- In K2, p2 rib pattern, 12 sts and 15 rows = 4"

**Special Abbreviations**

- beg:** begin(ning)
- BO:** bind off
- CO:** cast on
- dec:** decrease
- k:** knit
- k2tog:** knit 2 together
- p:** purl
- p2tog:** purl 2 together
- rem:** remaining
- rep:** repeat
- rnd(s):** round(s)
- st(s):** stitch(es)

**Hat**

With circular needle and A, CO 40 sts. Place marker and join in rnd, being careful not to twist sts.  
Beg knitting in k2, p2 rib; work even until piece measures 5".

**Crown**

- Rnd 1: \*K2, p2tog; rep from \* around.
- Rnd 2: \*K2, p1; rep from \* around.
- Rnd 3: With B, \*K2, p1; rep from \* around.
- Rnd 4: \*K2tog, p1; rep from \* around. (20 sts rem)
- Rnd 5: \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.
- Rnd 6: \*K2tog; rep from \* around. (10 sts rem)
- Rnd 7: \*K2tog; rep from \* around. (5 sts rem)

Continue knitting around on 5 stitches until stem measures 8".

**Finishing**

BO and weave in ends.  
Tie 8" stem into a knot and block as needed.

**Skill Level**

- Beginner

**Materials**

- Spud & Chloë Outer (100g/60yds): 1 hank A, 1 hank B
- Size 13 (9mm) 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size 13 (9mm) double pointed needles, or sized needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle
