



**Gauge**

In Stranded stockinette stitch, 28 sts and 36 rnds = 4"

**Special Abbreviations**

- CC: contrast color
- CO: cast on
- dec: decrease
- dpns: double pointed needles
- k: knit
- kfb: knit into the front and back of the stitch; one st increased
- k2tog: knit two together
- MC: main color
- meas: measures
- ndls: needles
- patt: pattern
- p: purl
- pm: place marker
- rep: repeat
- rnd: round
- RS: right side
- sl: slip
- sts: stitches
- st st: stockinette stitch
- WS: wrong side

**Experience Level**

Intermediate

**Materials**

- Spud & Chloë Fine (65g/248yds): 1 (2, 2) hanks MC, 1 hank CC
  - Size 3 (3.25mm) 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
  - Size 3 (3.25mm) double pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
  - Stitch marker
  - Tapestry needle
- Photo Shown: Sassafras #7808, Black Pepper #7825

**Sizes**

S (M, L)  
 For a slouchier style, make the largest size. Instructions are for smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. When one number is given it applies to all sizes.

**Finished Measurements**

Circumference: 18 (20, 22½)"  
 Depth: 9"

**Hat**

**Cuff**

Using MC and circular ndl, CO 108 (126, 144) sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to indicate beg of rnd.

**Ribbing rnd:** (k1, p1) around.

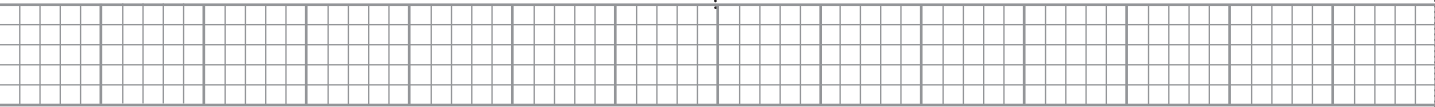
Work in Ribbing as set until piece meas 2½" from CO edge.

**Next Rnd:** \*k8, kfb; rep from \* to end. [120 (140, 160) sts]

Join CC and work all 45 rnds of chart, rep 10-st patt

12 (14, 16) times around.

Cut CC. Using MC, work five rnds st st.





**Crown**

Note: When dec at the crown, change from circular ndl to dpns or longer circular for Magic Loop method when sts are too few.

**Dec Rnd 1:** k2tog around. [60 (70, 80) sts]  
 K one rnd.

**Dec Rnd 2:** k2tog around. [30 (35, 40) sts]

**Dec Rnd 3:** k2tog to last 0 (1, 0) sts, k 0 (1, 0).  
 [15 (18, 20) sts]  
 End S and M here.

**Size L Only**

**Final dec rnd:** k2tog around. [10 sts]

**Finishing**

Cut MC and draw through remaining sts.  
 Pull tight and fasten off.  
 Weave in ends. Wet block.
